'Arm's reach supervision' helps prevent injuries.

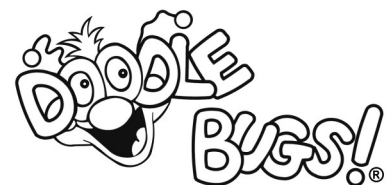
Playground Safety Reminders:

- **Separate to supervise. 'Zone supervision' means that teachers strategically place themselves in each area that is being used.**
- **Stand near a slide or play structure whenever it is in use. Your presence encourages children to use equipment safely.**
- **Avoid sitting down unless engaged in an activity. Reaction times are reduced when sitting; take an active role in children's play.**
- **Use age-appropriate equipment.**
 - **Toddlers are not permitted to use the large (2nd story) slide in the indoor play room. It is appropriate for ages 3+ with supervision.**
 - **Only School Ageders may use the 'swiss cheese' climber.**
