

Is everyone accounted for?

Count, count, and recount.



Children hide or linger behind for many reasons — illness, fear, wanting to play, feeling tired, feeling mischievous, etc. For their safety, keep the following in mind:

- **Children may never be left unattended—not even for a minute!**
- **Whenever children are leaving the classroom/playroom/playground, teachers must count, count and recount!**
- **When you reach your destination (classroom/playroom/playground), count, count and count again.**
- **When lining up, check restrooms, play structures and all potential hiding spots.**
- **When 2 adults are with a group of children, 1 adult should be the first person in line and 1 adult should be the last person in line.**
