- Avoid confusion for children & parents;
- Prevent lost items.

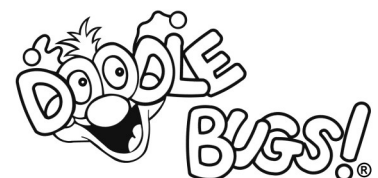
Teachers should not label children's clothing—instead, have a sharpie available for parents' use.
