labeled.

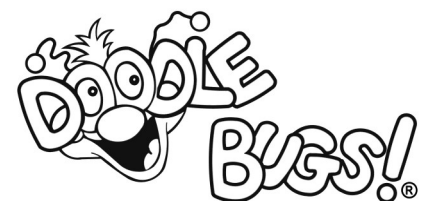


- OSHA (Occupational Safety & Health Administration) requires all chemicals to be labeled.
- This includes items not stored in their original containers (paint, glue, cleaning solutions, etc.)
- Please check all of your spray bottles and repurposed bottles (for example, ketchup bottles that you now use for paint).
- Pre-printed labels are available from the director. You can also use these for labeling infant bottles (parents sometimes forget!).
- Please cover labels with clear tape so they last longer.

OCFS Regulation 418-1.5 (a) Suitable precautions must be taken to eliminate all conditions in areas accessible to children which pose a safety or health hazard.

PA Code 3270.21 Conditions at the facility may not pose a threat to the health or safety of the children.
