As we transition into Summer Camp 2015, the June Math curriculum focuses solely on building growing competency and confidence in the early math skills you introduced throughout the school year; no new concepts are introduced.

Each Preschool classroom is expected to:

- 1. Support math readiness with music and with every day "math talk".
- 2. Offer a <u>Learning Center Activity</u> every day and vary this activity based on interest (typically weekly). Please select from the learning center options found here:

Revisit the preschool math centers from April and/or May,

Enjoy a variety of roll and count games.

Provide number cards, craft sticks, and writing tools to create a center where children:

- Choose a number.
- Select the appropriate number of craft sticks.
- Use the craft sticks to build.
- Draw a sketch of their creation.



Use a cardboard box to create a parking lot for toy vehicles. Number each parking spot and mark each vehicle with a number too (use a removable sticker or tape).
